Winegrowing-region Baden

The Baden region covers a distance of over 400 km from the Bodensee in the south up to Tauberfranken and is divided into nine wine regions.

Numerous varieties of grape flourish on an area of 16,000 hectares which present interesting sensory differences due to the different soil types and varying geographical features. Baden is the warmest German wine-growing area as a light Mediterranean breeze reaches the lower Rhine valley from southern France.

The region is also particularly famous for its pinots.

Vineyard area: 16,000 ha, made up of 56 % white wine

Main grape-varieties: Spätburgunder, Müller-Thurgau, Grauburgunder, Weissburgunder, Riesling

Well-known locations: Heidelberg, Freiburg, Baden-Baden

Soil: A great diversity of soils, which varies significantly between the nine regions in Baden.





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
